- 3. Log into CANVAS. Your instructions to access the course will include a link to access CANVAS. Enter your email address as your username and create a password. Once you have logged into CANVAS, you are free to complete the course at the time you choose.



- ✓ Explain why 2 component vaccines (e.g., vaccine and diluent, vaccine and adjuvant, or vaccine liquid and power components) have higher incidence of error report than single dose prefilled syringe vaccines.
- ✓ Identify ways in which vaccines can become invalid due to refrigerator temperature excursions that can lead to reduce vaccine potency and waste especially for vaccines that are considered short supply.
- ✓ Utilize safe administration practice by locating the thickest area and most central portion of the deltoid muscle for intramuscular injection in order to prevent severe shoulder injuries.
- ✓ Develop an important patient education process to send patients a reminder to come back and receive the 2nd COVID-19 vaccine for maximum effectiveness (not referring to the Johnson and Johnson vaccine yet which is a single dose.)


